New Liturgy Schedule for Holy Cross and St. John the Evangelist Churches: EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1st / 2nd

Saturday: 4:30 PM

At St. John's from June 1st – November 30th.

At Holy Cross from December 1st – May 30th.

- St. John's gets a lot of campers in the summer and people from Conneaut, OH who no longer have a Saturday evening liturgy.
- In the winter months, it would be easier to get musicians from Erie area to substitute on Saturdays if they did not have to drive as far as Girard.
- All of the neighboring parishes have liturgy at a different time than 4:30 (e.g. 4:00, 5:00, and 6:00). This would provide an option for those who cannot make the other liturgies at other parishes.

**Faith Formation for Grades K-5 to follow at St. John's from @ 9:30 – 11:00 AM*

Sundays 10:30 AM – at Holy Cross

**Faith Formation for Middle School [Edge Program] and Confirmation to follow at Holy Cross from @11:30 AM – 1:00 PM.*

***These sessions would be on alternating weekends and never on the same weekend.**

- These are more convenient liturgy times for parishioners without children in Faith Formation.
- Allows for a full hour and a half of Faith Formation in order to maintain a better number of contact hours with the children, per diocesan policy.
- Families with children in Faith Formation could most likely attend liturgy where their children have Faith Formation that weekend. Or they could attend on Saturday evening.
- It would be easier finding a substitute priest because of the shorter time between liturgies.

Weekday Liturgies at 8:00 AM

- **Tuesdays** – at Holy Cross
- **Wednesdays** – at St. John's
- **Thursdays** – at St. John's
- **Fridays** – at Holy Cross
