


Spiritual Opportunities at St. John's during Lent



- † Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 9:00 AM – 12 Noon every Friday of Lent (which does not include Good Friday)
- † Stations of the Cross every Friday at Noon at the end of Eucharistic Adoration (except Good Friday)
- † Celebration of the Eucharist every Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday at 8:30 AM
- † Opportunity for almsgiving through the Catholic Services Appeal
- † The Sacrament of Reconciliation every Saturday from 3:30 – 4:00 PM or by appointment.
- † ***“Night of Reconciliation and Adoration” will be held on March 19th from 4:30 PM to 6:30 PM. Receive the mercy of Jesus with the Sacrament of Reconciliation. And spend quiet time with Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament for prayer, reflection, and renewal. All are welcome.***
- † ***“The Light Is ON for You” will be celebrated again this year at most churches, in which a priest will be available for confessions on Wednesday, March 25th from 5:00 – 7:00 PM. St. John's will have the ‘Light On’ on Thursday, March 19th with the planned “Night of Reconciliation and Adoration” from 4:30 PM to 6:30 PM.***
- † Fasting between meals on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (for all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 58)
- † Abstaining from eating meat every Friday of Lent and Good Friday (for all Catholics 14 years old or older)
- † Prayerful participation in the Liturgy of the Eucharist every weekend (either Saturday at 4:30 PM or Sunday at 9:30 AM)
